

PhD co-tutelle in Information and Communication Sciences (Babes-Bolyai University and CY Cergy Paris University)

Proposed topic: Analysis of the mediatization and science communication processes related to the climate change technologies

Project Description:

The overarching research project, which includes a PhD conducted through cotutelle, aims to bridge the gap between scientifically-based knowledge on climate change technologies and its translation into social issues through media circulation. This investigation will also explore the impact of this transformation on geopolitical and governance-related contexts.

Expected Project Results:

By analyzing the trajectory of scientific reasoning, the project aims to shed light on the cycle of discourses that become dominant in the public sphere. It will examine how these discourses influence decision-making at both personal and public levels, highlighting the role of paradigms as influential factors in shaping discourse and its associated objects.

PhD Program Description:

- Admission to Babes-Bolyai University with a **subsidized position and a monthly scholarship**.
- The doctoral program spans a total of 36 months, with the PhD student spending **18 months at UBB** and **18 months at CY** and LPI. During their time at CY and LPI, they will receive an **additional stipend**. The student will have access to the scientific environment provided by LT2D, which includes a new research building at Cergy, an international atmosphere, linguistic tools for corpus analysis, and research seminars. Additionally, they will have the opportunity to work on the WeLearn platform and utilize additional databases of resources at LPI, while benefiting from training, mentorship, and code overview.
